

## QUILT SHOW EXHIBITOR INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Please read the following information very carefully. Quilts need to be categorized as defined below. These categories will help you in placing your quilt in the proper category for judging.

### DEFINITIONS

PIECED	piecing predominates over appliqué and other techniques either in amount or effect. The quilt must be more than 60% pieced.
APPLIQUE	Appliqué predominates over piecing or other techniques in amount or effect. The quilt must be more than 60% appliquéd.
OTHER TECHNIQUES	Includes quilts such as whole cloth, crazy quilts, yo-yo, etc.
MIXED TECHNIQUES	Any quilt that is a combination of piecing, appliqué and one or more other techniques so that less than 60% of the quilt is pieced or appliquéd.
INNOVATIVE/ART	The quilt is an art piece using an original design based on experiences, surroundings and ideas. It may include innovative techniques.
SMALL	Includes wall quilts and small quilts with a perimeter of 216 inches or less such as table toppers, runners, etc.
LARGE	Includes any bed-size quilts or throws with a perimeter of more than 216 inches. Quilts larger than 110" x 110" cannot be accommodated.

### GUIDELINES

- Entry forms will be accepted beginning July 8, 2019. **No entry forms will be accepted after September 17, 2019**
- Entries are limited to members of the Nite Owl Quilters Guild.
- Every effort will be made to hang every quilt that is entered, limited to five (5) quilted items per person plus challenge quilts. **Please prioritize your entries (one being your first priority) in the event that we are not able to accommodate all entries. If deemed necessary, Judge(s) may move an item to a different category.**

- All entries must be delivered to Cathy Primavera at 12807 Bridge Water Dr., Rancho Cucamonga, on October 12 or October 13 between 9:00AM and 5:00PM. Quilts must be picked up at the show site

between 5:30 - 6:30 on October 19. Entry receipt must be surrendered in order to pick up quilt.

### DEADLINE FOR ENTRY FORMS IS Sept. 17, 2019

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A separate form is required for each entry.
- Entries will not be accepted without a color photograph of the item with accurate quilt dimensions.
- Each item must have a label affixed to the back of the item with the name of the quilt, exhibitor's name, address and phone number.
- NOQG assumes no liability for entries that require special handling, such as those with fragile embellishments, special framing or hanging apparatus, and quilts that cannot be folded.
- Electronic flash photography is allowed at the show.
- INSURANCE is the sole responsibility of the entrant - can be covered under homeowner's policy in art category. Contact your agent.
- Exhibit quilt must match picture/entry form or will not be accepted.
- Soiled quilts or quilts with strong odors will not be accepted.

### AWARDS

Judging will be based on design, effective use of color, overall impact, balance (60%) and workmanship (40%). Judge(s) will make final determination as to eligibility of a quilt to be judged and whether an award will be given in each category.

### AWARD CATEGORIES

Pieced (more than 60% of quilt), Small and Large (1st-3rd)  
Appliqué (more than 60% of quilt), Sm. and Lg. (1st-3rd)  
Other Techniques (at discretion of judges)  
Mixed Techniques (any size) (1st-3rd)  
Innovative/Art (any size) (1st-3rd)
