

Starstruck Throw

Supply List

Project finishes at approximately 54" x 66"

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Background fabric

2-3/4 yards

You will need seventy-nine (79) 6-1/2" squares of background fabric

Star fabric

You will need five (5) 6-1/2" squares of fabric for each star. Set one square from each print aside for the star centers. The eight star points are made from four squares cut once on the diagonal.

20 fat quarters;

OR 20 6-1/2 width of fabric (WOF) strips;

OR 20 large scrap pieces

You can also go scrappy by using one print for the center square and making the star points from a different print.

You may wish, for added body, to use spray sizing or Best Press on both background and star pieces prior to cutting.

Note:

If you find yourself short on time, you do not need to cut all of your fabric prior to class. Minimum requirement to bring to class precut is:

32 6-1/2" background squares and

40 6-1/2" print squares (eight (8) sets of five print squares).

This will allow you to make eight stars during the workshop.

Sewing machine

Basic sewing supplies

A 6-1/2 inch square ruler is very helpful for both cutting the pieces and squaring up during construction.
