

Hooosketeer---Owl

Folded & Padded Hexagon Method

<Supply List>

-----I recommend batik cottons for this quilt.

1. background ivory or light beige batik cotton six strips of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
2. owl's body (color of your choice) seven strips of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
3. owl's wings, eyeballs & ears(color of your choice) four strips of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
4. owl's nose and two feet (yellow color) one strip of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
5. owl's eyes & tummy spots (white color) three strips of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
6. twig (brown color) two strips of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
7. leaves (green color) one strip of 5 1/2" x 42"-45"
8. fusible batting (low-loft)--- I used Hobbs' Heirloom fusible cotton batting---twin size or lap size
5. sewing machine with 1/4" foot, open-toe foot and walking foot
6. invisible thread (polyester is better) and matching color cotton threads
7. general sewing supplies---pins, scissors, markers, pins---
8. iron & ironing pad (small size works fine)
9. iron-on crystals for embellishment

(Circles we are going to use to fold hexagons include backing already. No need to bring backing material.)
